Our next guest preacher will be the Dean of Southwark, the Very Revd Dr Mark Oakley, who'll preach at High Mass *next Sunday* - do make a note of the date and come along to hear Dean Mark.

On *Friday, 5 July*, Fr Bill Wilson will preach at High Mass at 1930, marking the Rector's 25th anniversary of his Ordination as Priest. Prior to his retirement, Fr Bill was Vicar of St James's Sussex Gardens (he was the Rector's boss for a year!).

Audio Visual update

At its recent meeting, the PCC approved the purchase of an updated sound system for church and a new camera system, for streaming, in addition to associated equipment, all of which has now been ordered. The updated sound system will be digital rather than analogue and will be much clearer and more reliable. For streaming of services, there will be three mobile cameras around church, enabling opportunity to 'close in' at appropriate parts of the liturgy.

The cameras will be controlled via a mixing desk, laptop and iPad; with the associated software, the total cost is £26,000; donations to offset this amount will be gratefully received!
